BANQUETING AND PRIVATE DINING THE RITZ LONDON

The Ritz opened to great acclaim in 1906 and throughout its 100 year history the famous and the fashionable have been attracted to this legendary hotel. In 1995 The Ritz was returned to private British ownership and almost immediately a complete refurbishment began on the Grade 11 star listed building. Twelve years later the hotel has been fully restored with no detail left untouched. In 2002 The Ritz received a Royal Warrant for Banqueting and Catering Services. Awarded by His Royal Highness The Prince of Wales, The Ritz is the first, and only, hotel to have been honoured with this prestigious award.

In November 2006 The Ritz opened William Kent House, the Grade 11 star listed building adjoining the hotel featuring an exquisite collection of lavishly decorated reception rooms ideally appointed for both business or social entertaining. Designed in the 1740's by the renowned 18th century architect William Kent, from whom the house now takes its name, the historic mansion was acquired by The Ritz in 2005. After an extensive period of restoration and renovation in keeping with its original décor, the majesty of the William Kent House interiors is now resplendently reborn and five new banquet rooms provide a varied selection of venue space for elegant dining, bespoke meetings and conferences, gala occasions and weddings.

The most opulent of all the banquet rooms, the **William Kent Room**, is a spacious private dining room on the ground floor overlooking Green Park with seating for up to 24 for lunch or dinner. Featuring the most stunning original architecture in the house, the room is dominated by a breathtaking coved ceiling in grand Italian Renaissance style, highlighted in gold relief against a brilliant blue and red background. **Room hire charges (to include the Queen Elizabeth Room) from £4,000**

The **Queen Elizabeth Room** is a delightful drawing room style ante room with views over Green Park towards Buckingham Palace interconnecting with both the William Kent Room to one side and the Wimborne Room to the other. An elegant boardroom or private dining room for up to 16 people, the **Wimborne Room** is perfect for a corporate meeting room or a small lunch or dinner party.

Room hire charges from £1,500

The largest salon in the house, also on the ground floor, is the **Music Room** which accommodates up to 60 guests for a banquet dinner, 100 for a theatre-style meeting or 120 for a reception. The Music Room and its adjacent foyer, the **Reception Room**, both look over the inner courtyard. With its gold leaf mouldings, vaulted ceiling and slender Adamesque pilasters, this stately room epitomizes the grand and graceful style of the house.

Room hire charges from £2,500

A larger conference room, the **Burlington Room**, is situated in the first floor of the house and offers the ideal environment for formal meetings and presentations. Fully integrated, a magnificent 27 seat board table features connections for up to six lap tops and remote controls for the state of the art audio visual equipment. Conference delegates in the Burlington Room are ensured total privacy and discretion with individual technological arrangements tailor made to suit every requirement.

Room hire charges from £3,000

A further reception room located off the Long Gallery and adjacent to the Ritz Restaurant is the Marie Antoinette Suite. Accommodating up to 100 people for cocktail receptions and licensed for civil ceremonies, the suite is ornately decorated in the Louis XV1 house style of The Ritz.
